

**AMENDED ORDINANCE REGULATING GLASS CONTAINERS
IN PARK AREAS AND ON THE GUADALUPE RIVER AND CANYON LAKE**

WHEREAS, the Comal County Water Oriented Recreation District (W.O.R.D.) desires to reduce the danger caused by exhibiting, using carrying or dispensing of glass container in all parks owned or operated by W.O.R.D. and upon the Guadalupe River and Canyon Lake located within the geographic boundaries of W.O.R.D.; and


WHEREAS, Chapter 324, Section 324,066 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes W.O.R.D. to enter into reasonable rules and ordinances regarding activities that endanger the health and safety of persons on or in public water in the district.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following Amended Ordinance be adopted on this 17 day of August, 2022.


(A) To promote the public safety of persons recreating in the district, the exhibiting, using, carrying or disposing of glass beverage containers in parks owned or operated by W.O.R.D. or while on or in Canyon Lake and on or in the Guadalupe River within the geographical boundaries of the district is PROHIBITED.


(B) Any person or business violating this order shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor offense.


(C) This Amended Ordinance becomes effective on Aug. 17, 2022.
